

Application Terms and Conditions

The Mission of the North American Christian Convention is as follows:

“The NACC is the connecting place, providing ideas, inspiration, and identity to New Testament churches, ministries, and their leaders.”

Submitting this Application to Exhibit indicates you are in harmony with the Statement and Purpose of the NACC outlined below:

“The NACC is an open gathering of Christians; it is not a delegate convention or a convention of churches. The NACC provides a non-denominational opportunity for Christians to come together to hear grace and truth preached, participate in inspiring singing, attend insightful workshops, engage in strategic networking, connect through enriching fellowship, and visit resourceful exhibits. Hosted by independent Christian Churches and Churches of Christ, the NACC gives special emphasis to the restoration of the church according to the plan revealed in the New Testament.

The exhibit hall is reserved for exhibitors whose mission, product(s) and/or services are integral to the life and ministry of Christ’s church and/or individual Christians. The NACC exhibit hall is not intended to be an open marketplace for any idea or merchandise simply because the vendor may be a Christian. Exhibitors whose mission, product(s), and/or services clearly contribute positively in various environments to various demographic groups in areas such as worship and music, preaching, educational ministry, group life/fellowship, Christian service, evangelism, cross-cultural missions, recreational ministry, membership involvement, counseling, pastoral care, benevolence, leadership, management, administration, office services, financial services, stewardship development, facility and campus management, are welcome to make an application for space to exhibit. Any group which intends to display, distribute, or sell any Sunday School curriculum or any literature teaching the plan of salvation may first be required to submit samples to the NACC office for review.”

It is to be understood that presence in the NACC exhibit hall or program book does not represent endorsement by the NACC or churches/individuals who attend the NACC.

What you can and can not sell ...

This set of guidelines has been compiled listing products and services that are not in harmony with our policy. *The enforcement of this policy has nothing to do with the NACC’s dissatisfaction with any particular person or vendor organization.* The determination of whether your organization falls within the spirit of what this policy is trying to accomplish is left to the discretion of the NACC Exhibit Coordinator.

- Products or services offered for sale must provide a demonstrable unique benefit to Churches and/or ministries.
- Displaying organizations offering products or services for sale must be able to demonstrate that Churches and/or ministries are a specific target of their marketing efforts.

The following missions, products and services will NOT be accepted in the Display Hall:

- air or water filters
- herbs and / or vitamins
- kitchen appliances or implements

Other items are accepted at the discretion of the Exhibit Coordinator. Items offered for sale must be disclosed and approved in advance by the Exhibit Coordinator. The NACC Exhibit Coordinator and Managing Director reserve the right to order the removal of any product offered for sale without prior approval.
